NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Milpitas City Council will hold public hearing on Tuesday, August 4, 2015 at 7:00 PM in City Hall Council Chambers, 455 E. Calaveras Blvd., 2nd floor, Milpitas, CA on the following:

WEED ABATEMENT ASSESSMENTS: On Tuesday, January 6, 2015, Milpitas City Council adopted Resolution No. 8433 declaring noxious or dangerous weeds growing upon certain described property to be a public nuisance which must be abated by the removal of the weeds. The resolution is on file in the City Clerk's office and a copy can be viewed on the City's website www.ci.milpitas.ca.gov. If the public nuisance was not removed from the properties by the owner, it was removed and the nuisance abated by the City of Milpitas. The cost of removal will be assessed and made a lien upon the land from which, or in front of, the weeds were removed or such other remedies may be invoked as the law allows.

The public hearing will be the time and place to hear all property owners having objections to the proposed assessment for the cost to remove weeds.
