OUR PURPOSE

OUR PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE DISCIPLINED AND MOTIVATED YOUNG ADULTS WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO "EXPLORE" LAW ENFORCEMENT AS A POSSIBLE CAREER CHOICE. TO THAT END, WE ATTEMPT TO EXPOSE MEMBERS TO ALL FACETS OF POLICE WORK INCLUDING: RIDING WITH OFFICERS AS THEY WORK A BEAT, WRITING REPORTS AND PARTICIPATING IN TRAINING EVENTS.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE INTERESTED IN A CAREER IN LAW ENFORCEMENT.
APPLICANTS MUST HAVE NO MAJOR CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS.
APPLICANTS MUST OBTAIN A 2.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA).
APPLICANTS MUST BE FREE OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE.
APPLICANTS MUST BE WILLING TO LEARN.
APPLICANTS DO NOT HAVE TO BE MILPITAS RESIDENTS.

SELECTION PROCEDURE
