POLICE ARREST REPEAT BURGLARY SUSPECT

Date: July 3, 2010, Saturday, 6:37 a.m.
Location: 100 BK South Main Street, Milpitas
Case: 10-184-055
Suspect: Douglas Carl Wiley, 39-year-old male, (transient)



On July 3, 2010 (Saturday), at approx. 6:37 a.m., the suspect was seen climbing out of a window to a closed business holding a cash register drawer in his hands. A witness began yelling at the suspect who then dropped the register and ran away from the scene. Another witness followed the suspect while police officers were en-route. Officers arrived in the area and stopped Wiley, who matched the description. Wiley was positively identified as the person who was observed committing the burglary.

Officers located burglary tools and several pieces of evidence, which were later linked to other burglaries. Wiley was booked at the Santa Clara County Jail for two counts of burglary, possession of burglary tools and stolen property.

Douglas Wiley is a local transient from Milpitas. In addition to the above offenses, he was recently arrested on June 12, 2010, for burglarizing a kiosk within the Great Mall. At the time of this press release, Wiley remained in jail. However, should Wiley be released from custody, community members are highly encouraged to call the Police Department anytime Wiley is observed within any areas acting suspiciously or without apparent lawful business.
