





Serial Vandalism Suspect Arrested

Date: September 13, 2010
Location: 400 Blk Barber Lane, Milpitas
Case: 10-256-091
Suspect: Nancy Chi Ni, 30-year-old female, San Jose resident
Suspect Vehicle: 2009 BMW 328, Black



On September 13, 2010 at 1:51 p.m. a Milpitas police officer saw the suspect, identified as Nancy Ni, walking in a local shopping center and acting suspicious near a parked Mercedes Benz vehicle. Ni then left the vehicle and approached another parked Mercedes Benz vehicle. The officer saw Ni scratching the sides of the vehicle with a metal object in her hand. The officer immediately arrested Ni for felony vandalism and took her into custody. The officer returned to the first vehicle and noticed it had been vandalized in the same manner.

Ni was released on bail, during the commission of this offense, for multiple counts of similar vehicle vandalisms. On June 8, 2010, Ni was arrested in Milpitas for vandalizing a Mercedes Benz. She has been linked to cases in the cities of Pleasanton, Sunnyvale and Santa Clara. In all other known cases, Ni has been involved vandalizing BMW and Mercedes Benz vehicles.

Ni was booked into the Santa Clara County jail for multiple counts of felony vandalism and committing a crime while being released on bail.
