Milpitas Police Arrested Prowling Suspects

Date: October 20, 2010
Location: Meadowland Drive, Milpitas

Suspect #1: Sherwin Roux Delim, 37-year-old male resident of Sacramento
Suspect #2: Kao Koy Saephan, 27-year-old male resident of Sacramento
Suspect #3: Kao Fey Saechao, 23-year-old male resident Sacramento
Suspect Vehicle: Black 1996 Acura Integra coupe

On October 20, 2010 (Wednesday), at 12:22 P.M., a resident called 9-1-1 and reported several suspicious people near a home on Meadowland Drive. Two males repeatedly knocked on the front door of the home and rang the doorbell. When no one from the home responded, the two males went into a vehicle that was parked nearby and that was occupied by a third male. The two males then returned to the home, and the caller heard the sound of the side gate opening.

The caller remained on the telephone with the 9-1-1 operator and provided detailed responses to the operator's questions about the incident. The caller was able to describe the suspects in detail and provided a description & the license plate number of the involved vehicle.

Officer Chris Salazar drove towards Meadowland Drive while the caller was still talking to the 9-1-1 operator. Armed with the information provided by the caller, Officer Salazar spotted the involved vehicle leaving the area and traveling on North Milpitas Blvd. Officer Salazar conducted an investigative stop and ultimately arrested the above listed three suspects for prowling & conspiracy after determining they had plans to burglarize the home.

Kao Saephan (Suspect # 2) also had an active warrant, and Kao Saechao (Suspect #3) was also arrested for possession of burglary tools, driving with a suspended license, and having two active warrants. All three suspects were booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail.
