### **BOMB THREAT**

**Date:** November 16, 2010  
**Location:** Phoenix Technologies, 915 Murphy Ranch Road  
**Case:** 10-320-069  
**Suspect #1:** Unknown male

On November 16, 2010, at approximately 11:38 a.m., Milpitas Police Officers responded to a bomb threat at Phoenix Technologies, located at 915 Murphy Ranch Road. An unidentified male called an employee at 11:15 a.m. and said there was a bomb in the building and that it would go off in 30 minutes.

Approximately 200 employees were evacuated from the building. Milpitas Police Officers and Management conducted a walk-through of the business and did not locate any suspicious devices. Employees returned to the business at approximately 12:59 p.m.
