ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING

Location: 250 (Blk) Roswell Drive

Victim #1: 17 year-old female, Milpitas resident
Suspect #1: Unknown Hispanic male adult

On February 3, 2011 at approximately 8:30 a.m., a Calaveras Hills High School student was walking to school on Roswell Drive, when an unknown Hispanic male adult walked passed her in the opposite direction. The suspect turned around, began following her and said something to her is Spanish. The victim, not knowing the suspect, continued to walk away at a faster pace and immediately called her mom on her cell phone. The suspect began chasing the victim and ran up from behind her, at which point he attempted to grab her. She turned away from him and fled onto the Calaveras Hills High School campus where she notified a School Resource Police Officer.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male adult, 20 to 30 years of age, short black hair wearing a two-toned blue hooded sweat shirt and blue jeans, approximately 5'-8" tall, physically fit and spoke Spanish. The suspect was last seen running northbound on Carnegie Dr.

Milpitas Police Department Detectives are currently investigating 2 prior incidents that occurred on January 24th involving a suspect described as an Asian male. These events occurred within the 1600 block of Everglades Drive and 400 block of North Park Victoria Drive respectively. The suspect in today's event differs in description from the previous cases.
