### **RESIDENTIAL BURGLAR**

**Date:** February 24, 2011, Thursday, 8:30 a.m. – 1:25 p.m.  
**Location:** Courtland Avenue near Mt. Shasta Avenue  
**Case:** 11-055-101  
**Suspect #1:** Unidentified male, possibly 50-60 years old, about 6'-00" to 6"-04" tall, lean build, white or gray hair, and last seen wearing a light colored baseball cap, an olive colored long-sleeved collared shirt, tan pants, & white athletic shoes.  
**Suspect Vehicle:** 70's - 80's possible Ford full size van, light blue, with stickers or a temporary registration sticker on the right-rear window.

On February 24, 2011, between 8:30 a.m. and 1:25 p.m., a residential burglary occurred on Courtland Avenue. The suspect climbed over a six-foot fence to get into the rear yard of the residence. He then smashed a rear glass door and stole jewelry before leaving. During the investigation, officers discovered the unidentified suspect and his vehicle were recorded on a neighbor's surveillance system.
