Milpitas Police Arrest Sex Offender with Stolen Car

On Monday, April 4, 2011, Sergeant Tim Campbell, of Milpitas Police Department, located an unoccupied stolen car in the parking lot of Executive Inn on Dempsey Road, in Milpitas. After watching the car for about 30 minutes several officers saw Francisco Munoz, a transient from San Jose, get in the car and start to drive away. When officers tried to stop Mr. Munoz he got out of the car and tried to flee on foot. Officers caught Mr. Munoz and he wrestled with officers to avoid arrest. Officers were eventually able to handcuff Mr. Munoz.

After he was arrested, it was discovered that Mr. Munoz was a parolee who refused to contact his parole officer, and he is a registered sexual offender who was not compliance with his registration requirements. He had also cut off his ankle bracelet tracking device and been on the run for several months. Mr. Munoz had methamphetamines and a lock pick device in his possession.

Mr. Munoz was booked into Santa Clara County jail for possessing a stolen car, drugs, drug paraphernalia, failure to register as a sex offender and resisting arrest.
