Milpitas Police Arrest Sexual Battery Suspect at the Great Mall

Suspect: Jorge Luis Colmenero, 42-yr-old male resident of San Jose
Case: 11-101-134

On Monday, April 11, 2011, at 6:23 pm Milpitas Police Department officers responded to a report that a male subject was video recording under the skirts of female customers inside the Burlington Coat Factory department store. Store security officers saw the subject, later identified as Colmenero, walking in the store carrying his cell phone and reaching below the skirts of the female customers in order to capture video of undergarments.

Milpitas Police Department officers contacted Colmenero in the store and found him in possession of a video camera, which he previously had strapped to his shoe, and a cell phone. After he was arrested, it was discovered that had taken video segments under the skirts of females in the mall and inappropriately touched a female juvenile.

Mr. Colmenero was booked into Santa Clara County jail for surreptitiously video recording for sexual gratification, annoying or molesting a child under 18, and sexual battery.
