## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Indecent Exposure and Lewd Act with a Child**

**Date:** April 26, 2011 Tuesday, 3:53 p.m.  
**Location:** 600 (Blk) Sequoia Dr. at Shenandoah Ave.  
**Case:** 11-116-131  
**Victim #1:** 12 year-old female, Milpitas resident  
**Victim #2:** 13 year-old female, Milpitas resident  
**Suspect #1:** Unknown Hispanic or Asian male adult

On April 26, 2011 at approximately 3:53 p.m., two juveniles left their school campus and were walking on Sequoia Drive. The two juveniles noticed a Hispanic or Asian male adult standing on the sidewalk taking pictures of them. When they went to pass the suspect, he grabbed victim #1 on the shoulder with his hand and prevented her from walking past him. The suspect then pulled his pants down with his other hand and exposed his genitals.

The victims ran away from the suspect and the suspect fled eastbound on Shenandoah Avenue. One of the students phoned a parent to pick them up near the incident. The Milpitas Police Department was notified of the incident and searched the area for the suspect. The suspect remains at-large and the case remains under investigation.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic or Asian male adult, 20 to 25 years of age, short black hair wearing a black baseball cap, black leather jacket and blue jeans, approximately 5'-8" to 5'-10" tall, approximately 170 to 200 pounds.
