## PRESS RELEASE

### Residential Burglary

**Date:** May 10, 2011, Tuesday, 12:00 P.M.

**Location:** 100 block Casper Street, Milpitas, CA 95035

**Case:** 11-130-087

**Suspect #1:** Unknown Hispanic or Vietnamese male, 22 to 30 years-old, 5'-07" to 5'-08" in height, and last seen wearing a white T-shirt and blue jeans.

**Suspect #2:** Unknown Vietnamese male, 20 to 22 years-old and last seen wearing a baseball cap.

**Suspect Vehicle:** Blue 2007 Honda Civic LX, four-door with California License plate # 6AJM561

**Details:** On May 10, 2011 at approximately 12:00 P.M., a residence in the 100 block of Casper Street in Milpitas was burglarized. A conscientious neighbor observed an unknown Vietnamese male, 20 to 22 years-old wearing a baseball cap sitting in a blue 2007 Honda Civic LX, four-door with California License plate # 6AJM561. The neighbor said the vehicle and driver were not familiar to the area. The same neighbor observed another suspect, described as an unknown Hispanic or Vietnamese male, 22 to 30 years-old, 5'-07" to 5'-08" in height, and last seen wearing a white T-shirt and blue jeans running through his front yard. This suspect entered the Honda while it was in motion and they were last seen driving away from the area.

Milpitas Police officers arrived into the neighborhood and searched for the suspects and vehicle. Simultaneously, the victim called and advised he had interrupted a burglary. Milpitas Police officers learned suspect #1 forced entry into the residence via a bedroom window, but fled prior to taking anything from residence.
