### Indecent Exposure

**Date:** June 22, 2011, Wednesday, 12:50 p.m.

**Location:** Dollar Tree Store  
1350 S. Park Victoria Drive

**Case:** 11-173-101

**Victim:** 50 year-old female, Milpitas resident

**Suspect:** Rumualdo Camacho Meza, 42 year-old male, Transient

On June 22, 2011, at approximately 12:50 p.m., Milpitas police officers responded to a report of a suspicious person inside the Dollar Tree store located at 1350 S. Park Victoria Drive. The victim said the suspect, who was identified as Rumualdo Meza, was following her throughout the store and fiddling with his pant zipper.

Milpitas Police Officers contacted Meza inside the store and found his pants were unzipped and his genitals were exposed. He was arrested for indecent exposure and taken to the police department. He provided officers with a false name, but after being fingerprinted his true name was revealed. We also discovered he had a no bail warrant for his arrest for disorderly conduct.

Meza was booked into Santa Clara County main jail on the warrant, providing a false name to a police officer, delaying an officer in the course of his / her duties and indecent exposure. The District Attorney's office charged him with one count of indecent exposure.
