## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Reported Shooting Being Investigated**

**Date:** March 9, 2012, Friday, 12: 39 p.m.  
**Location:** 1400 block of South Main Street, Milpitas  
**Case:** 12-069-100

On March 9, 2012, at approximately 12:39 p.m., the Milpitas Police Department received a 9-1-1 call from a citizen reporting a shooting on South Main Street. The caller indicated a subject had been shot. The citizen reported seeing a gun and hearing the gun discharge. The shooter was last seen wearing all black and running westbound on Cedar Way from South Main Street. The subject who had been allegedly shot was seen running to the rear of Jerry's Deli on South Main Street. Milpitas Police Officers responded to the area and located two subjects to the rear of Jerry's Deli. The two subjects were taken into custody without incident and a handgun was recovered at the scene. The two subjects showed no signs of being the victim of a gunshot wound, but are believed to be involved.

Zanker Elementary was placed on lock down while officers searched the area. Zanker Elementary was closed for approximately one hour and has since been reopened.

A gunshot victim has not been located and local hospitals have been notified of the incident.
