SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON

DATE: August 29, 2012
LOCATION: 400 (B) Easter Ave., Milpitas
CASE #: 12-242-073
VICTIM: 25 year-old male Milpitas resident
SUSPECT: Ray Ricardo Trujillo, 24 year-old San Jose resident
DETAILS:

On August 29, 2012 at approximately 11:12 AM, Milpitas Police Department officers responded to a report of possible gunshots heard in the 400 (B) Easter Ave. Residents in the area reported they heard possible gunshots and saw a car rapidly leave the area. Officers checked the area but did not locate any evidence to indicate gunshots had been fired or signs of anyone injured by gunfire.

Several hours later, officers identified a witness to the shooting and discovered a victim had been injured with a non-life threatening injury. The investigation identified the suspect as Ray Ricardo Trujillo, 24, of San Jose.

On August 30, 2012, Milpitas Police Department detectives located Trujillo in San Jose and, with the assistance of the San Jose Police Department, took Trujillo into custody for assault with a deadly weapon. Trujillo was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail on the charges of assault with a deadly weapon, possession of a loaded firearm, under the influence of a controlled substance and a parole hold.


