Commercial Burglars Arrested

DETAILS:

On September 24, 2012, at approximately 2:15 P.M., Milpitas police officers responded to the 1600(b) of McCandless Dr. on a report of a suspicious vehicle in the area. The occupants of the vehicle were seen accessing a vacant commercial building on McCandless Dr. after parking their vehicle on Houret Ct. and sneaking through a hole in a chain link fence. Officers quickly arrived on scene and began setting up a perimeter around the vacant building. The suspects were apprehended as they exited the building after stripping metal and wire from within the building. All three men were identified, arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Jail.

Gregory Matthew Mackin and Jeremy Allen Ring were arrested for commercial burglary. Ty Scott Thurston attempted to flee from the officers and was arrested for commercial burglary and resisting arrest.
