Automobile/Pedestrian Traffic Collision-Update

Location: 800 (Blk) Montague Expressway at S. Milpitas Boulevard
Case: 12-307-146
Pedestrian: 82 year-old male
Driver: 39 year-old female, San Jose resident
Vehicle: Silver 2012 Toyota Prius

On November 2, 2012 at approximately 6:42 p.m., the Milpitas Police Department and the Milpitas Fire Department responded to a traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian pushing his wheelchair on Montague Expressway near the intersection of S. Milpitas Boulevard.

The pedestrian was transported by paramedics to a local hospital.

The driver, a 39 year-old female San Jose resident, did not require any medical attention. She remained at the scene with the involved vehicle, a silver 2012 Toyota Prius. The investigation is on-going.

On November 16, 2012, at 9:20 p.m., the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries.
