Commercial Burglary / Involuntary Manslaughter

Suspect: Alvaro Julio Quiane-Aquino, 31- year-old male, San Jose, resident

Decedent: 25 year-old male, San Jose, resident

Details:

On April 28, 2013, Sunday, 9:44 A.M., Milpitas police officers responded to a vacant business at the 1400 block of McCandless Drive for a report of an explosion where one person reportedly suffered serious burns. Upon arrival, officers located suspect Quiane-Aquino along with a 25 year-old male companion lying on the ground. The 25 year-old man suffered severe burns to most of his body. The injured man was immediately transported to a nearby hospital where he was treated for third degree burns. He died from his injuries on April 30, 2013.

Milpitas Police Detectives investigated the incident and determined Quiane-Aquino and his 25 year-old friend were attempting to steal copper wiring and other recyclables from the vacant building. The decedent attempted to cut a live electrical wire which caused the explosion resulting in his severe injuries. Quiane-Aquino was immediately arrested and booked for burglary, possession of narcotics and drug paraphernalia. Upon further investigation, Quiane-Aquino was also charged with involuntary manslaughter because the decedent died while both suspects were in the process of committing a felony.
