Residential Burglary Suspect Arrested

DATE: May 20, 2013
LOCATION: 600 Block of London Drive
CASE #: 13-140-064
SUSPECT #1: Terrell Jamar Rhodes, 20 year-old, San Francisco resident
SUSPECT #2: Unknown black male, approx. 20 years-old, 5'7, 160 lbs, black hair wearing an unknown color t-shirt

On May 20, 2013, at approximately 12:21 p.m., a resident reported suspicious persons knocking on her front door but decided not to answer her door. A short time later, the resident saw one suspect, later identified as Terrell Jamar Rhodes, a 20 year-old San Francisco resident, in her backyard. Rhodes opened her sliding screen door and began tampering with her rear sliding door to her residence. The resident called the Milpitas Police Department and an officer arrived on scene within 2 minutes. As officers were setting up a perimeter around the residence, an incoming officer saw Rhodes running away from the area and jumping over a fence into a neighbor's backyard. An extensive perimeter was set with the help of additional units from the Fremont Police Department. A yard-to-yard search was conducted with the help of a Milpitas Police K-9 and Rhodes was eventually found hiding in a shed located in the backyard of a residence on Stratford Drive. The second suspect was not located and is still at large.

A computer check revealed Rhodes had recently been released on bail and had an outstanding warrant for his arrest. Rhodes was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for burglary, resisting arrest, prowling and committing an offense while being released on bail. He was also booked for his outstanding warrant.
