SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN STOLEN VEHICLE INVESTIGATION

Suspect #2: Earl Linwood Pike, 43 year-old male, Campbell resident
Vehicle #1: 2006 Ford F150 Pickup
Vehicle #2: 1989 GMC 350 Pickup

On June 27, 2013 at approximately 1:30 P.M., Milpitas Police Detectives went to the 600(B) of Walsh Avenue, in Santa Clara, to follow-up on a tractor-trailer theft investigation that originated in Milpitas, on April 29, 2013. Detectives contacted Anderson and another person in the parking lot of Facilities Logistics, in Santa Clara. Anderson was in possession of Vehicle #1. Detectives also located Pike, who is Anderson's acquaintance, in the parking lot. Pike was in possession of a Vehicle #2. Upon further investigation detectives discovered both vehicles were previously reported stolen within Alameda County. Additionally, Detectives discovered Pike was out on bail for a pending auto theft case in Calaveras County.

Anderson and Pike were arrested and booked for possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of a stolen vehicle with a prior conviction, and possession of stolen property. Pike was also booked for committing a felony while out of custody on bail.
