**ATTEMPTED RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECT ARRESTED**

**SUSPECT:** Daniel Robert Bobba, 28 year old, transient.

On July 22, 2013, at about 11:38 a.m., MPD Officers responded to a 9-1-1 call from a residence at the 1001-blk of S. Main St. The victim reported an unknown suspect attempted to force open the front door of the residence however fled on foot prior to police arrival. As officers searched the area, a neighboring resident called MPD to report a male subject hiding in their patio area. Officers surrounded the area and located the suspect hiding under some loose clothing. After further investigation, the officers determined the suspect attempted to force entry into a second home by prying a window. Although they were not able to confirm the suspect was responsible for the first attempted burglary, the officers arrested the suspect for the second attempted burglary.

The suspect was identified as Daniel Robert Bobba, a 28 year old transient, who was on probation for drug offenses. Bobba was booked into Santa Clara County Main Jail for attempted residential burglary.
