FRAUD SUSPECT ARRESTED

SUSPECT #1: Cary Toves, 46-year-old, Ceres resident

On October 5, 2013 at approximately 6:03 P.M., Milpitas Police officers responded to the Wells Fargo Bank, located at 1715 Landess Ave., on a report of a fraud in-progress. Milpitas Police officers arrived and detained the suspect inside of the bank while he was trying to pass a check which had been reported stolen from the City of Fremont. The suspect was identified as Cary Toves, a Ceres resident, and a computer check revealed he was on active Post Release Community Supervision (P.R.C.S.) probation for possession of stolen property. Toves also had outstanding warrants for his arrest. He was arrested without incident.

Cary Toves was booked into Santa Clara County Jail for burglary, check fraud, possession of stolen property and his warrants.
