RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED

On September 4, 2014, a Milpitas Police Department detective saw several males running from a backyard of a home on Arizona Avenue, and the males fled from the scene in the above listed vehicle. Detectives from additional law enforcement agencies followed the suspect vehicle where it eventually parked in a residential neighborhood in San Jose. The males committed a residential burglary in San Jose and were taken into custody with the help of officers from the San Jose Police Department. It was determined the suspects tried to break into the home on Arizona Avenue in Milpitas by attempting to force open a door. The vehicle used by the suspects was previously reported as a stolen vehicle.

The suspects arrested were identified as Anthony SantaCruz, two 16-year-old male juveniles, and a 17-year-old male juvenile. Among other criminal charges, the suspects were arrested for the attempted residential burglary in Milpitas. Anthony SantaCruz was booked into Santa Clara County Main Jail, and all three juveniles were booked into Santa Clara County Juvenile Hall.
