Residential Burglar Arrested

On Friday, November 14, 2014 at approximately 1:04 A.M., a Milpitas Police sergeant was conducting a traffic stop, on the 1700 block of South Main Street in Milpitas, when he heard someone yelling about a house being burglarized. The sergeant observed two men running southbound on South Main Street and realized a victim was chasing the suspect down the street. The sergeant engaged in the foot pursuit and chased the suspect into a nearby business parking lot. The sergeant, who happens to be the Milpitas SWAT Supervisor, overtook the suspect and captured him without further incident. Milpitas Police Officers later learned the suspect had scaled up a wall, to a second floor balcony, and entered the victim's home through an unlocked sliding door. Once inside the home, he was confronted by the victims and chased out of the front door. The victims did not have any property taken from their home.

The suspect was later identified as Norman DeCampo Desumala, a 33 year-old Fremont resident. Norman DeCampo Desumala was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for residential burglary, possession of a controlled substance, and possession of drug paraphernalia.
