**SUSPECT IN-CUSTODY FOR CHILD ENDANGERMENT AND EVADING POLICE**

**VICTIM:** 5 year-old male, Milpitas, California resident  
**SUSPECT:** Morris (nmn) Foster, male, 56 year-old, Milpitas, California resident  
**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** 2001 Chevrolet 2500 van, white  
**TIME ELEMENT:** Wednesday, November 26, 2014; 5:55 P.M. to 6:38 P.M.

On Wednesday, November 26, 2014 at approximately 5:55 P.M., Milpitas Police Officers responded to the 1100 block of Edsel Drive in Milpitas, where a mother reported her 5 year-old son missing. The mother was concerned because she had left her son with her boyfriend, has a history of using illegal drugs and both of them were not home when she arrived. While officers were present, the boyfriend drove pass the victim's house and an officer attempted to stop him to welfare check the child. The boyfriend evaded officers and led them on an approximately 4-mile vehicle pursuit until the vehicle was disabled by the police. The boyfriend was eventually taken into custody and the 5 year-old male was found in the cargo area of the van. The 5 year-old male was unharmed and reunited with his mother.

The boyfriend was identified as Morris Foster, a 56 year-old Milpitas resident. Foster was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for felony child endangerment, felony evading, driving with a suspended driver license, under the influence of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs..
