RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED

DATE: January 22, 2014

SUSPECT #1: Torrio Sanders, 22-year-old Oakland resident

SUSPECT #2: Javante Parks-Roberson, 20-year-old Oakland resident

SUSPECT #3: Arnaud Bowman, 24-year-old Oakland resident

SUSPECT #4: Malika Morris, 20-year-old Oakland resident

On 01/21/14, at 12:43 P.M., an eye witness called the Milpitas Police Department to report four suspicious people in a backyard. The suspects reportedly jumped over a fence and fled in a tan SUV. It was later determined that a home in the neighborhood had been burglarized.

A responding Milpitas Police Detective saw two people matching the suspect descriptions running on S. Main St. and into a business complex. Several officers responded to assist and took two suspects into custody.

A third suspect was seen running eastbound towards a residential complex under construction on McCandless Dr. Milpitas Police Officers and detectives set a perimeter around the complex while a separate MPD search team conducted a sweep of the area. A SJPD helicopter happened to be nearby and was able to provide aerial support. The suspect was found hiding in a kitchen cabinet of a home under construction. He was arrested.

A fourth suspect was taken into custody on S. Main St. while attempting to flee the area. The suspect vehicle, a tan Jeep Cherokee, was located parked nearby. Several items found in the SUV were later determined to be stolen property from three separate residential burglaries; one in Milpitas and two in San Jose which occurred earlier that day.

The suspects were later identified as Torrio Sanders, Javante Parks-Roberson, Arnaud Bowman, and Malika Morris, all from the City of Oakland. All were booked into the county jail for residential burglary.

Additionally, Sanders was booked for providing a false name to police officers, and for a parole violation, Bowman for an active arrest warrant, and Morris for possession of stolen property, and an active arrest warrant.
