RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED

LOCATION: 1800-Blk Shenandoah Avenue

SUSPECT #1: 16 year-old male, San Jose resident

SUSPECT #2: Luis Osmar Partida, 19 year-old, San Jose resident

SUSPECT VEHICLE: White 2001 Chevrolet Silverado Truck

On 03/17/14, at 8:55 A.M., Milpitas Police Officers responded to the report of a possible burglary in-progress at a residence located on the 1800 block of Shenandoah Ave.

A Milpitas Police Officer arrived at the location as the call was being dispatched and began setting a perimeter. While awaiting the arrival of additional police officers, the officer saw a male suspect (Suspect #1) enter the backyard of a residence and shortly thereafter walk away from the residence, carrying a bag. The second suspect drove past him in a White Chevrolet Silverado truck and stopped to pick him up when they were both detained. Further investigation revealed the suspect had forced entry into the house and stole electronic equipment.

Suspect #1 was identified as a 16 year-old male, San Jose resident, who is currently on probation for burglary. Suspect #2 was identified as Luis Osmar Partida, a 19 year-old, San Jose resident. Suspect#1 was arrested and booked into Juvenile Hall for burglary, conspiracy, and violation of probation. Luis Partida was arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for burglary and conspiracy.
