SEX OFFENDER ARRESTED

SUSPECT: Benjamin Studer, 50-year-old Milpitas Resident

On April 17, 2014, at 8:00 A.M., Milpitas police officers went to a residence in the 1800 block of Conway Street to contact a registered sex offender who was believed to be out of compliance with sex offender registration requirements. As a precaution, the Milpitas Police Department requested that school personnel and students at Weller Elementary School and the Sunnyhills Child Development Center “shelter in place” until the scene was secured.

Benjamin Studer, a registered sex offender, was contacted at the residence. He was arrested for failing to register as a sex offender with the Milpitas Police Department. The residence was secured by police officers and the “shelter in place” was lifted.

Benjamin Studer was booked into Santa Clara County Main Jail for a felony charge of failing to register as a sex offender.
