Mental Health Incident

SUBJECT: 51 years old male, Milpitas resident

On June 10, 2014 at 7:58 PM, a person phoned the Milpitas Police Department and expressed concerns that a male resident was distraught and conveyed information that led officers to believe the resident might harm himself. The caller informed the Milpitas Police Department that the resident had access to a firearm stored in the home.

At approximately 9:32 p.m., Milpitas Police officers persuaded the person to exit the residence and surrender. A 12 gauge Smith and Wesson shotgun and a Colt Marc II .45 caliber handgun were eventually recovered inside of the home. No one was injured during the incident.

The subject was identified a 51-year old male Milpitas resident. The subject was taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for a mental health evaluation.
