THEFT SUSPECT ARRESTED

SUSPECT: Dionne Marche Gulley, 30 years-old, Milpitas resident

On June 16, 2014 at 5:13 P.M., a resident from Burdett Way reported the theft of a package from their front porch. A Milpitas Police officer investigated the theft and obtained information regarding a possible suspect and associated vehicle.

On June 17, 2014 at 3:35 P.M., the officer who originally investigated the theft from Burdett Way saw the suspect vehicle on the 600-blk of N. Park Victoria Drive. The officer contacted the driver of the vehicle, who was Dionne Gulley. The Milpitas Officer found the package stolen the previous day in Gulley's vehicle and found Gulley was in possession of a package stolen from a residence in San Jose, earlier in the day. Gulley was arrested for two counts of possession of stolen property and petty theft. Gulley had outstanding warrants for theft and driving on a suspended license. Gulley was booked at the Santa Clara County Main Jail for the aforementioned offenses.
