DUO ARRESTED FOR POSSESSION OF STOLEN FIREARM

SUSPECT #1: Kendall Hamberry, 23-year-old Milpitas resident
SUSPECT #2: Lima Ioane, 24-year-old Pittsburg resident
SUSPECT VEHICLE: 1999 Chevy Lumina, Maroon

On July 17, 2014, at 4:01 P.M., the Milpitas Police Department received a report of a possible armed robbery in progress at the 800-block of Coyote St. Milpitas officers were on scene within a minute of the call and stopped the suspect vehicle as it was leaving. After detaining all of the occupants, it was determined that no robbery had occurred. However, during a search of the suspect vehicle, three loaded handguns were located, including one stolen during a residential burglary in Citrus Heights, CA. in 2012.

Hamberry was arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail for possession of a concealed firearm in a vehicle and possession of a stolen firearm. Ioane was arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail for possession of a concealed firearm in a vehicle, convicted felon in possession of a firearm, possession of a stolen firearm and convicted felon in possession of ammunition.
