Felony Evading and D.U.I. Suspects Arrested

SUSPECT #2: Randy Molina Agustin, 35-year-old male, Morgan Hill resident
SUSPECT VEHICLE: Blue, 2004 Jeep Grand Cherokee

On Monday, April 6, 2015, at approximately 10:25 p.m., a Milpitas Police Officer attempted to stop a Jeep Grand Cherokee for suspicion of driving while under the influence drugs or alcohol. The vehicle failed to yield and a pursuit was initiated. The pursuit terminated, in the City of San Jose, when the driver eventually complied with the officer and stopped his vehicle. The driver of the vehicle, Scott Gow, and a passenger, Randy Agustin, were taken into custody without incident. Gow displayed signs of being under the influence of methamphetamine while driving the vehicle and had a parole violation warrant for his arrest. An illegal weapon similar to brass knuckles was found inside of Gow's vehicle as well.

Scott Anthony Gow was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for felony evading, driving while under the influence of a controlled substance, being under the influence of a controlled substance, possession of an illegal weapon and the warrant.

Randy Molina Agustin was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for two narcotic related warrants.
