Grand Theft Arrest

SUSPECT #1: Christopher Cox, 54 year-old San Jose resident
SUSPECT VEHICLE: 1999 Chevrolet Blazer, blue

On May 3, 2015, at about 1:40 p.m., a Milpitas Police officer was checking a business at the 1801 (B) of McCarthy Blvd. that had been previously burglarized. The officer located a blue Chevrolet Blazer with an attached trailer inside a fenced off area of the business. A large electric motor was loaded onto the trailer. Officers searched the area around the business and located the owner of the vehicle, later identified as Christopher Cox, a 54 year-old San Jose resident. Officers determined Cox was at the business unlawfully and did not have permission to take the electric motor. The owner of the electric motor valued the equipment at \$4,000.00.

Cox was arrested and booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail on one count of grand theft. The equipment was returned to the owner and Cox's vehicle was towed from the scene.
