**AUTOMOBILE BURGLARS ARRESTED**

**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** 2001 Lincoln LS sedan, dark blue

On June 18, 2015, at 6:17 a.m., the Milpitas Police Department received a call of an automobile burglary that just occurred in the parking lot of 7-Eleven, 190 West Calaveras Blvd. A witness saw a suspect taking items from the victim's truck as it was parked in the parking lot, and the suspect fled in a dark blue Lincoln LS sedan driven by another suspect. The victim had been inside the store but soon discovered one of the windows of his truck had been smashed and his briefcase was stolen. His briefcase contained several items, including his iPad, and he was able to use his smart phone to track his iPad, which was located at a hotel on Dempsey Road in Milpitas.

Officers located the dark blue Lincoln LS sedan in the parking lot of the hotel on Dempsey Road and conducted surveillance until Antonio Sanchez returned to the sedan. He was arrested, and officers saw additional items stolen from the victim in the sedan. Officers identified the hotel room Antonio Sanchez came from, and they arrested his brother, Ray Sanchez, in the room after finding additional items stolen from the victim. Antonio Sanchez and Ray Sanchez were booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail for several offenses, including automobile burglary and possession of stolen property.
