COMMERCIAL BURGLAR ARRESTED

On August 21, 2015, at about 3:12 A.M, Milpitas Police Officers responded to 1426 Dempsey Rd. (Stuff Pizza) on a report of an alarm activation. When officers arrived, they discovered the back door of the business had been pried open and a burglary had occurred.

Officers reviewed the business video surveillance cameras, and it captured a suspect entering the business. An officer recognized the burglary suspect as being Craig Irvin Brayfield from prior contacts. Brayfield is a local transient in Milpitas.

At 6:52 A.M., officers located Brayfield at a local transient encampment in Milpitas and arrested him without incident. Brayfield was booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail for burglary.
