Felony Evading and Warrant Arrest

SUSPECT VEHICLE: 1999 Honda Civic, Green

On Friday, November 20, 2015 at approximately 12:45 P.M., a Milpitas Police Officer observed a Green 1999 Honda Civic commit a minor traffic violation on the 1400 Block of Landess Ave. The officer followed the vehicle and conducted an enforcement stop on the 1100 block of East Calaveras Blvd. The vehicle fled in a reckless manner to the 1500 block of East Calaveras Blvd. Once the vehicle came to a stop, the driver, Uriel Contreras, ran from the vehicle and barricaded himself inside of a friend's residence on the 1600 of East Calaveras Blvd. Officers surrounded the home and negotiated his peaceful surrender.

Uriel Contreras was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for felony evading, resisting arrest, a felony probation warrant, a felony narcotic warrant, and a felony warrant for smuggling contraband into a jail.
