**Felony Evading, Assault with a Deadly Weapon on an Officer,
Possession of a Stolen Vehicle, Possession of Stolen Property**

DATE: December 21, 2015
LOCATION: 301-block Ranch Drive, Milpitas, Ca

SUSPECT 1: Kenneth Ty Gadberry, 49 year-old, San Jose, California transient
STOLEN VEHICLE: 2000 Subaru Outback, Blue

On Monday, December 21, 2015 at approximately 2:00 A.M., a Milpitas Police Officer located a Blue 2000 Subaru Outback parked in a parking lot of the 301 Block of Ranch Drive. A records check on the license plate revealed it was reported stolen. However, the VIN number and license plate did not match. Officers observed the suspect, later identified as Kenneth Gadberry, enter the driver's door and start the vehicle. Officers conducted a high-risk stop on Gadberry. Gadberry accelerated backwards into a marked patrol vehicle causing damage. He then accelerated forward striking three parked vehicles. Officers pursued Gadberry through the parking lot and he eventually turned the vehicle around and purposely drove head-on into the same patrol vehicle. When Gadberry's vehicle was unable to escape, he was taken into custody.

Kenneth Gadberry was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for felony evading, assault with a deadly weapon on a peace officer, possession of a stolen vehicle, and possession of stolen property.
