Felony Evading and Assault with a Deadly Weapon

SUSPECT #1: Joshua Jason Bonilla, 38-year-old male, Fremont Resident
SUSPECT #2: Julie Ann Stump, 36-year-old female, Hayward Resident
SUSPECT VEHICLE: Grey, 2000 Dodge Durango

On Wednesday, June 3, 2015, at approximately 11:46 p.m., a Milpitas Police Officer attempted to stop a Dodge Durango for suspicion of driving while under the influence of alcohol. The vehicle failed to yield and a pursuit was initiated. The driver, Joshua Bonilla, rammed a police vehicle which terminated the pursuit in Milpitas. Bonilla then fled from the vehicle and led officers into a foot pursuit. The passenger, Julie Stump, remained in the vehicle and was taken into custody without incident. A search was conducted and a Milpitas Police canine located Bonilla hiding in the backyard of a residence. Bonilla was in violation of a restraining order with Stump being the protected party, was in possession of drug paraphernalia, and he had a parole violation for assault on a police officer with a deadly weapon.

Bonilla was treated at a hospital and was later booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for felony evading, driving while under the influence of alcohol, assault on an officer with a deadly weapon, resisting arrest, restraining order violation, prowling and possession of drug paraphernalia and a parole violation warrant.

Stump was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for being under the influence of drugs.
