**Fatal Hit and Run Traffic Collision (Update #3)
Suspect Identified**

Date: April 15, 2015
Location: 900 (BLK) North Milpitas Boulevard @ Jacklin Road
Case: 15-035-020
Suspect: Alex Alcazar 23 year-old male, Milpitas, California resident
Deceased Victim: 14 year-old female, San Jose, California resident
Vehicle: Silver 1992 Cadillac El Dorado 2-door

On February 4, 2015, at approximately 3:36 A.M., the Milpitas Police Department responded to a hit and run traffic collision involving a silver 1992 Cadillac El Dorado which fled the scene of the crash. Police officers arrived at the scene and followed the debris which led to the 800 (BLK) of Coyote St. Officers located the Cadillac stopped along the east curb line. A 14 year-old female was located on the roadway next to the Cadillac. She died from injuries suffered during the collision.

Alex Alcazar has been identified as the driver of the 1992 Cadillac El Dorado. A warrant has been issued for his arrest. Alcazar is being charged with violation of 20001(a)/(b)(2)CVC (Hit and Run resulting in a fatal injury), 23105CVC (Reckless Driving resulting in a fatal injury), and 14601.1a CVC (Driving on a suspended drivers license).

The Milpitas Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in locating Alex Alcazar. Alex Alcazar is a resident of Milpitas and his current whereabouts are unknown. If you have information about Alex or his whereabouts, please contact the Milpitas Police Department.
