POSSESSION OF A STOLEN LOADED GUN AND PAROLE VIOLATION

SUSPECT 2: Jose Flores, 34-year-old Male, Stockton Resident

On March 16, 2015, at approximately 5:09 A.M., Milpitas Police Officers conducted a traffic stop at the 1800 block of Barber Lane. The officer determined the driver, Glemelynn Reyes, was not in possession of a driver license, and the passenger, Jose Flores, and was on parole for domestic violence. During the investigation, officers discovered Glemelynn Reyes was concealing a stolen loaded firearm in her clothing.

Glemelynn Reyes was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of a concealed loaded firearm. Jose Flores was booked for violating his parole.
