TRIO FROM PORTLAND ARRESTED

SUSPECT #3: Jupiter Ganynede Marley, 27 year-old male, Portland, OR resident
TIME ELEMENT: Friday, March 20, 2015 at approximately 7:50 P.M.

On Friday, March 20, 2015 at approximately 7:50 P.M., a victim notified the Milpitas Police Department that his 1997 Honda Civic was stolen earlier in the morning in San Jose and his credit card, which was inside of his stolen vehicle, was used at a local Milpitas hotel.

Milpitas Police Officers responded to the motel and contacted Syrrita (nmn) Mason in the rented room. As officers were questioning Syrrita Mason, her boyfriend, Anthony Raymond Boyle, arrived at the motel and was identified as the person who used the stolen credit card to rent the room. Both Syrrita Mason and Anthony Raymond Boyle were taken into custody without incident.

During the course of the investigation, officers learned Anthony Raymond Boyle was driving a black Acura Integra prior to officers arriving at the motel. Officers checked the area and located the 1995 black Acura Integra in the parking-lot of 380 South Main Street, which is just a few businesses north of the motel. The Acura Integra was occupied by Jupiter Ganynede Marley, who was seated in the driver seat. Milpitas Police Officers learned the black 1995 Acura Integra was stolen in Napa, California on March 19, 2015. Jupiter Ganynede Marley was also taken into custody without incident.

Anthony Raymond Boyle was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property, fraudulent use of a credit card, possession of drug paraphernalia, and for being under the influence of a controlled substance. Syrrita Mason was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of stolen property, possession of drug paraphernalia, and for being under the influence of a controlled substance. Jupiter Ganynede Marley was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property, possession of drug paraphernalia, under the influence of a controlled substance, and a drug related warrant.


