**STOLEN PROPERTY AND NARCOTIC SUSPECTS ARRESTED**

**SUSPECT #4:** Jamie Michelle Rutherford, 35-year-old female, San Jose, resident  
**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** 1999 Dodge Durango, black

On July 5, 2016, at approximately 11:15 P.M., a Milpitas Police Officer located a suspicious black Dodge Durango backed into a parking stall in the parking lot of the Embassy Suites located at 901 E. Calaveras Blvd. The officer contacted four occupants inside the vehicle who were later identified as 34-year old Brandon White, 35-year-old Sean Finn, 31-year-old Santana Roa and 35-year-old Jamie Rutherford, all residents from the City of San Jose. White initially provided the officer with a false name and date of birth; however, his true identity was determined which revealed he had a felony warrant for his arrest for probation violation out of Santa Clara County. White was also found to be in possession of methamphetamine. Finn had a felony warrant for his arrest for probation violation out of Santa Clara County and was in possession of two separate California driver's licenses which he claimed he found a week prior. Roa was also found to be in possession of methamphetamine.

During the course of the investigation, officers searched the Dodge Durango and located a backpack containing a wallet, California driver's license and Costco card belonging to an unrelated female subject. It was later determined the female was the victim of a strong armed robbery that occurred on June 21, 2016 in San Jose. White, Finn, Roa and Rutherford could not explain how the three items ended up inside the vehicle. Brandon White was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of a controlled substance, possession of stolen property, providing false information to an officer and his warrant. Sean Finn was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of stolen property, misappropriation of found property and his warrant. Santana Roa was cited and released for possession of a controlled substance and possession of stolen property. Jamie Rutherford was cited and released for possession of stolen property.


