**POSSESSION AND TRANSPORTATION
OF MARIJUANA FOR SALES**

DATE: July 31, 2016
LOCATION: 100-BLK Marylinn Drive, Milpitas

SUSPECT #1: Luis Cesar Jimenez-Garcia, 26 year-old male, San Jose resident
SUSPECT VEHICLE: Gold 1996 Acura TL

On July 31, 2016, at approximately 3:17 P.M., a Milpitas Police officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop of a Gold 1996 Acura TL for a vehicle code violation on Marylinn Drive. The officer contacted the driver and a passenger. The officer immediately recognized the odor of marijuana emitting from the vehicle. The driver verbally provided identification information, which was later determined to be false. A search of the vehicle revealed over two (2) pounds of marijuana. Once the driver's true identity (Luis Jimenez-Garcia) was determined, a computer check revealed he was on probation in Santa Clara County and he did not have a valid driver license. Luis Jimenez-Garcia was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession and transportation of marijuana for sales, providing a false name to an officer, and driving a vehicle without a valid license.
