IDENTITY THEFT AND NARCOTIC SUSPECTS ARRESTED

On September 8, 2016, at approximately 1:05 P.M., Milpitas Police officers responded to the Staybridge Suites at 321 Cypress Drive on a report of suspicious individuals carrying large bags and walking back and forth between the hotel lobby and three cars in the parking lot. Officers saw a female, later identified as Holly Mikaele, standing next to a black 2001 Lexus with the driver's side door and trunk open in the parking lot. A male, later identified as Ngaoi Nguyen, was seen walking back and forth between the Lexus and a gray 2005 Mercedes that drove out of the parking lot. Officers contacted Mikaele and Nguyen. Mikaele was on probation from Alameda County. Nguyen originally provided officers with a fictitious name and date of birth; however, it was later learned he was on probation from Alameda County and had a felony arrest warrant from Alameda County for identity theft.

During the course of the investigation, officers searched the Lexus Mikaele was seen standing next to. Fictitious driver licenses with Mikaele's image and an address of a victim in El Sobrante, papers containing personal biographical information for other individuals, and methamphetamine were found

inside the car. Officers searched a silver 2001 BMW belonging to Nguyen and located a credit card embosser, multiple printers, a laminator, and fictitious driver licenses containing personal biographical information for several other people.

The gray 2005 Mercedes returned to the area of the hotel, and officers contacted the driver, later identified as Kim Luu, and the front passenger, later identified as Arnold Batuyong. Luu had three misdemeanor warrants for his arrest from Santa Clara County for narcotic related offenses. Batuyong was on probation from Alameda County and had a fictitious California driver license. Officers searched the Mercedes and located over an ounce of methamphetamine, empty plastic baggies, and drug paraphernalia. Luu was found to be in possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia.

Ngoai Nguyen was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for identity theft, possession of fictitious identification cards, manufacturing fictitious identification cards, violation of his probation, and his warrant. Holly Mikaele was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for identity theft, possession of fictitious identification cards, possession of methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia, and violation of her probation. Kim Luu was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession of methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia, and his warrants. Arnold Batuyong was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for possession and transportation of narcotics for sales, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of a fictitious identification card, and violation of his probation.
