TRESSPASSING, PROWLING AND NARCOTIC SUSPECT ARRESTED

LOCATION: Rancho Middle School, 1915 Yellowstone Avenue

SUSPECT #1: Kimo Samuel Ruiz, 24-year-old male, San Jose resident

On October 13, 2016, Milpitas Police Officers responded to Rancho Middle School on a report of a stranger washing his face in a bathroom on the campus. When staff members at the school attempted to contact the man, he fled from them on a bicycle. Responding officers searched the surrounding residential areas and were initially unable to locate the man. Approximately 30 minutes after officers first arrived in the area, an alert resident on Skyline Drive called the Milpitas Police Department to report seeing a man exit the side yard of a home. The description of the man on Skyline Drive was similar to the description of the man seen at Rancho Middle School. Officers located the man, later identified as Kimo Ruiz, riding his bicycle on Shenandoah Avenue and took him into custody without incident.

During the course of the investigation, approximately one gram of methamphetamine and two glass narcotic pipes were found in Ruiz's possession. Ruiz had two felony warrants from the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office. Ruiz was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for trespassing upon school grounds during school hours, prowling, possession of methamphetamine, possession of drug paraphernalia and the two warrants.
