ARMED ROBBERY AND PETTY THEFT SUSPECTS ARRESTED

On January 24, 2016 at approximately 6:41 A.M., officers responded to Safeway on a report of an armed robbery that had just occurred. Several suspects exited the store with beer, hard alcohol and sandwiches which they had shoplifted. When an employee asked one of the suspects if he was going to pay for the items, he removed a knife from his waistband and brandished it at the employee in order to flee the area. The suspects were seen fleeing the parking lot in a red 2010 Hyundai Accent. A Milpitas Police Officer located the vehicle on Smithwood Street.

During the course of the investigation, six individuals were identified as being involved in the theft of the items, and Trevor Hall was identified as the suspect who was armed with the knife. Trevor Hall was booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for armed robbery and conspiracy to commit a crime. Robert Delgado, Enrique Hernandez, Edward Leal and Anthony Davis were booked into the Santa Clara County Jail for petty theft and conspiracy to commit a crime. Additional video surveillance was retrieved from Safeway that showed Sarah Davis was involved in the theft of the items. She was later cited and released at her residence for petty theft and conspiracy to commit a crime.

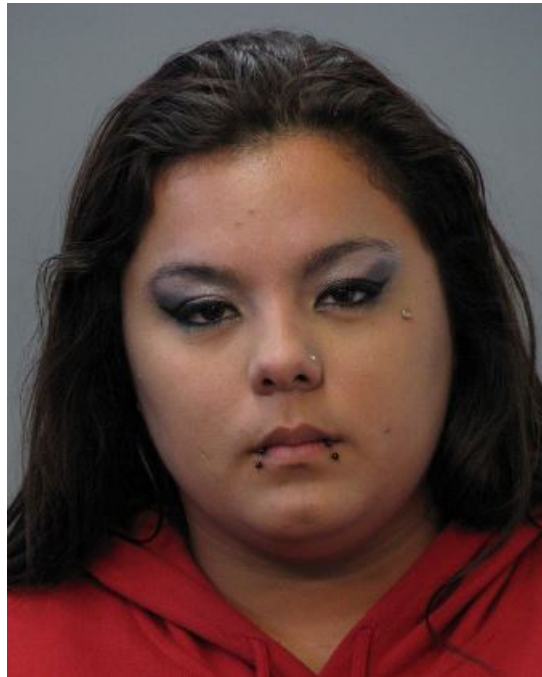
