MILPITAS POLICE NEEDS HELP IDENTIFYING BURGLARY SUSPECT

LOCATION: 440 (block) Dixon Landing Road- Mill Creek Apartments

SUSPECT: African-American male, approximately six (6) feet tall with a heavy build, last seen wearing a black beanie, green shirt, black jacket with a white Nike Air Jordan logo on the left side of the chest, black gloves, and dark jeans.

The Milpitas Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in identifying and locating the residential burglary suspect shown in the photo.

On January 29, 2016, at about 8:50 am, a Milpitas Police Department officer investigated a residential burglary at the Mill Creek Apartments, 440 Dixon Landing Road in Milpitas. The victim returned home and discovered her residence was ransacked and her personal belongings stolen. The surveillance footage showed the Suspect as an African-American male, approximately six (6) feet tall with a heavy build, and last seen wearing a black beanie, a green shirt, a black jacket with a white Nike Air Jordan logo on the left side of chest, black gloves, and dark jeans.
