RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECT ARRESTED

SUSPECT #1: Joseph Stamaria, 30-year-old Milpitas resident

On 2/22/16 at 2:24 P.M., an alert resident called the Milpitas Police Department when he heard glass breaking, saw a neighbor's window smashed and a man climbing inside the neighbor's home.

Milpitas Police Officers arrived and set a perimeter around the house while the suspect was still inside. The suspect came out the back of the home and attempted to jump over the backyard fence when he was challenged by Milpitas Police Officers. He then retreated back into the house and ignored repeated commands to surrender. Officers eventually entered the home and located the suspect hiding in the garage. He was arrested without further incident.

The suspect was identified as 30-year-old Milpitas resident, Joseph Stamaria. He was booked into the Santa Clara County jail for residential burglary, resisting arrest, and for being under the influence of a controlled substance. Stamaria was also being investigated for stealing packages off of residential porches in Milpitas prior to this incident.
