Goal of the Awards

The Neighborhood Beautification Awards Program was established to recognize and reward City of Milpitas residents, property owners, neighborhoods, community groups and business establishments, for improving their front yards with new landscaping, improvements and maintenance.

Minimum Requirements

- One form per nominee and per each category for a total of 4 per household must be *received by July 31st*.
- An individual may nominate a resident, a community group, homeowner association, apartment complex, multi family unit, mobile home, a business, restaurant or school that is within Milpitas city limits (anonymous nominations will be disqualified).

*Properties in violation of building, municipal and/or zoning codes will not be eligible.

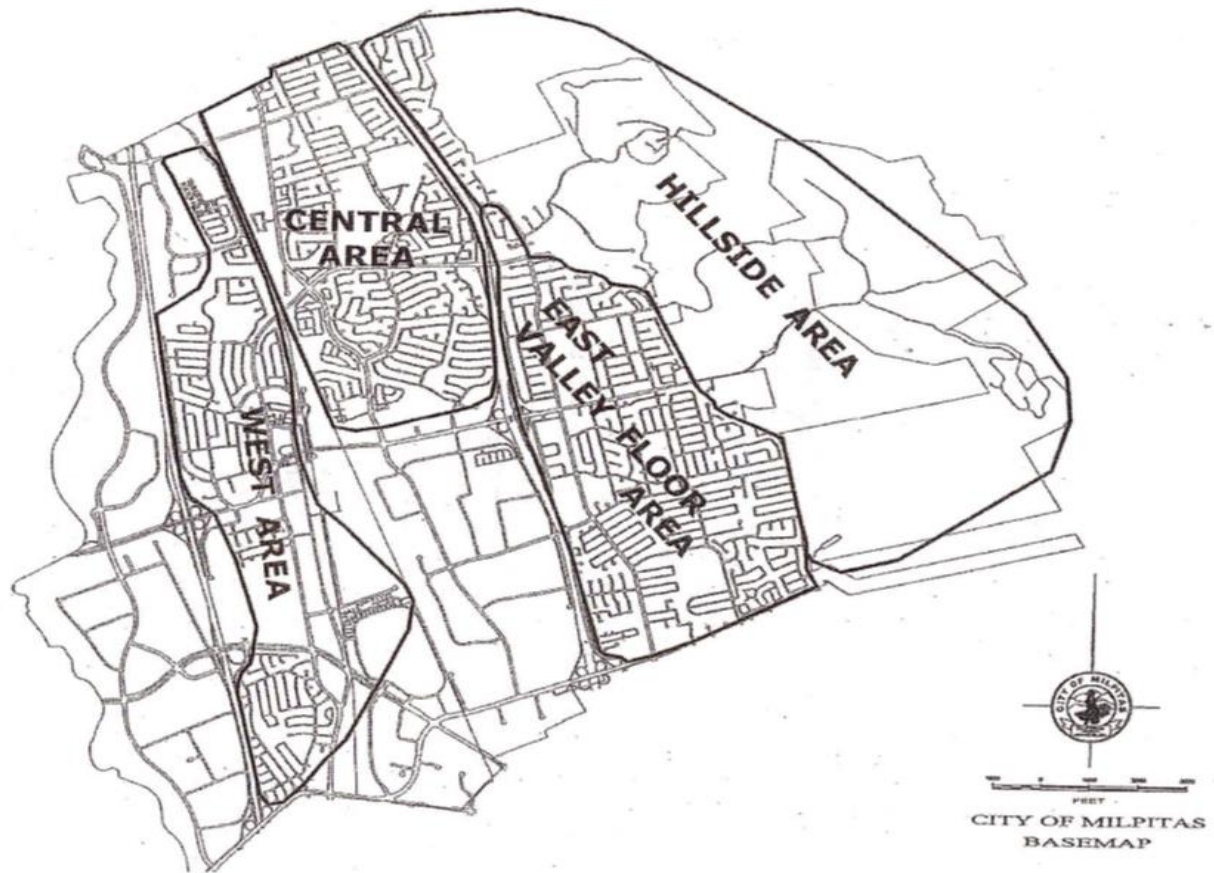
*The subcommittee reserves the right to move a nomination into a different category

Award Categories

Awards will be given from one of four categories:

1. ***Attractive Residential Property***: This category focuses on a single- family home.
2. ***Attractive Multi-Family Property***: This category focuses on mobile homes, apartment complexes, and duplexes etc.
3. ***Attractive Non- residential Property***: This category focuses on non- residential properties including (restaurants, businesses, medical offices, and shopping centers).
4. ***Building a Sense of Community***: This category focuses on how an organization, school, or business has created an environment that positively impacted the city of Milpitas.

An award winner will be selected from each of the four sections of the City including the Hillside Area, East Valley Floor Area, Central Area, and West Area.



All properties will be judged on their visible aesthetic appearance from the street.

Awards

All the winners and nominees will receive a Certificate of Recognition issued by the City of Milpitas. The certificates will be handed out at a City Council meeting by the Mayor and pictures of the properties will be on the City website and the City Cable Channel 15.
