Many of you may have come across the OES Booth at the Food Festival last month— we taught about gas meters, emergency preparedness via radio communication, training, etc. One important program OES runs is SAFE, and this August OES is providing the SAFE certification Program FREE to Milpitas residents. You will learn how to damage assess buildings, how to triage an injury, how to report information effectively for first responders, and where tools are within your immediate community to be self sufficient. In a major earthquake, it may take DAYS before first responders show up. The SAFE program gives you the tools and training to empower you to take care of yourself, your family, your coworkers and your neighborhood until help can arrive.

Quick Tips:

- ✓ Diapers, medicine, pet needs, those everyday things you don't think about - but can't go without!
